Our initial meeting with you will be to understand your idea or need. Then we will recommend a tailored workshop for you.





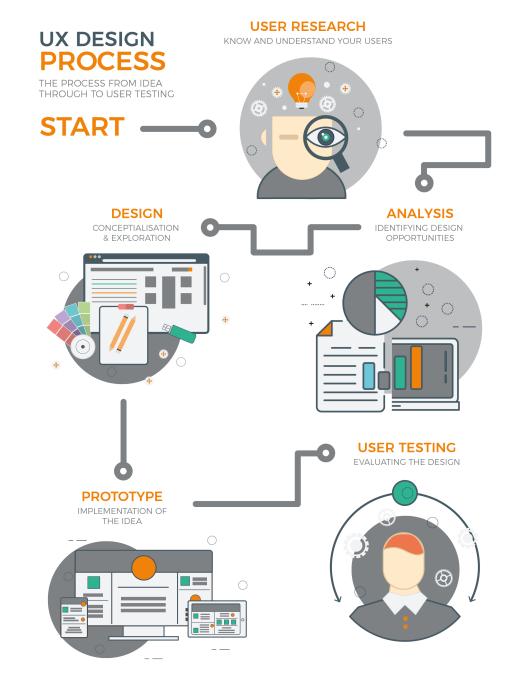


UX Design

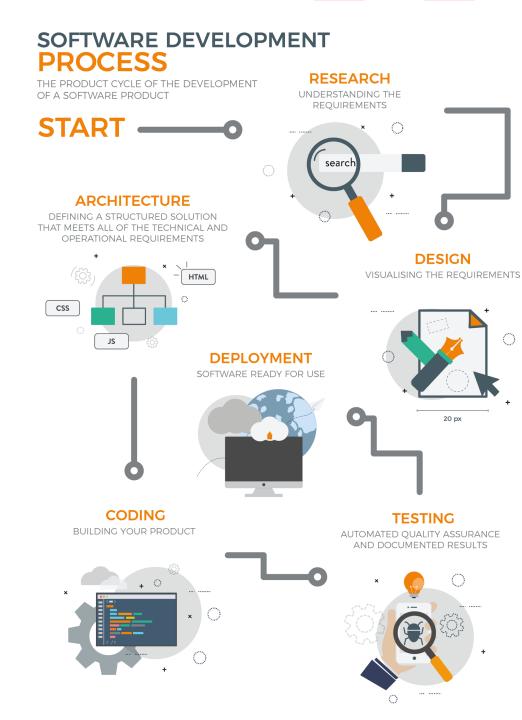
At the end of the process, you will have a usable simulation you can use for testing of real users, or for development.



Software Development

Our development process is based on delivering highest value first. Once designed, your MVP (Minimum Viable Product) will be divided into manageable chunks. We'll plan these chunks into two week iterative pieces called, sprints. At the end of each sprint you will receive completed software.

During each sprint, you will also work closely with our designers to create acceptance criteria for the User Stories in the next sprint. This means that what you have specified will be developed and ready for testing in a very short time.

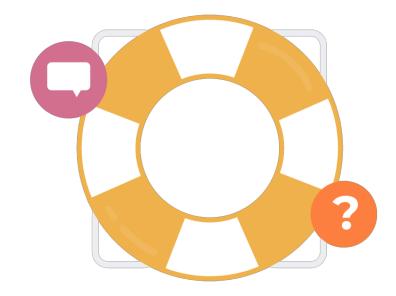


Support & Maintenance
